
Beverly Yacht Club Common Race Signals 2025

Description: means a sound; five short dashes - - - - - means repetitive sounds; a long dash — means a long sound. * When a visual signal is displayed under a class flag, the signal applies only to that class.





postponed. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless postponed or abandoned




Races not started are postponed. Further signals ashore.

AP over A (Alpha) Races not started are postponed. No more racing today.




The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is abandoned again or postponed.


